

System 3 Producer, Live Act



Piero Scarato, aka System 3 (but also the man behind many well known names in the hardcore techno-scene, such as Max E-Crew, Crime Lab, Deevoid...) started his career in 1991, dj'ing and playing with an Akai sampler at small parties and clubs. He released his very first record in 1994 - Vitamin Pills "Saturn Rings" with D. Baraldo (with whom he started this adventure) and DJ Ottomix (aka Joe Inferno/Black Machine).

The following year he signed an exclusive contract with one of the best hardcore labels ever: D-Boy records. System 3 started releasing strong music, including "Keep on fuckin'", "The devil inside", "Da Beat", etc... immediately getting international recognition for the quality and innovation of his music. Following that success two new pseudonyms were created, Max E-Crew and Crime Lab.

After leaving D-Boy Records System 3 started the label Aeon Tracks, releasing classic hits like "Like a shot", "Smash it" and more music under the name of Deevoid. Having released over 60 singles and countless compilations, collaborations and remixes, Piero Scarato established himself in the elite group of the early hardcore pillars.

After a long absence from live performance, in 2007 he was contacted by superstar DJ Dano, who thought that it was time to bring System 3 back on stage, starting with a couple of clubs in Amsterdam and one of the best festivals ever: the Ground Zero Festival. System 3 also was asked to write 2 official anthems for the 2009 edition.

Nowadays System 3 has released some new music like: One of Us e.p. (on Neurotoxic Records with The Sickest Squad) and a collaboration with DJ Dano, a remix of the classic "Take me away" for Technohead on Mokum Records.
